
## Animals in the heat

The wildlife at Cleland is well adapted to summer conditions in the Mount Lofty Ranges. By finding the coolest, shadiest position within their enclosure, kangaroos, wombats, Tasmanian Devils, bandicoots and wallabies can avoid the worst of the day's heat by lying quietly and breathing slowly.

Please be aware of the animals' needs when approaching them on a hot day.

Koalas are more inactive than normal on hot days and may climb down to the base of their tree, or perch to take advantage of the coolness of the ground. If the temperature exceeds 35 degrees within the wildlife park, the handling of Koalas does not occur, due to the level of discomfort for the animals.

Alternative sessions with the Koala staff are available on these days, and further information may be obtained from the ticket staff on entry to the park.



## BALEEN WHALES

BALEEN WHALES OR FILTERS GROW DOWN FROM THE JAW FRINGED MUSTACHE, COMBING THE TINY PLANKTON, KRILL AND SMALL FISH FROM THE WATER PASSING THROUGH THE WHALE'S MOUTH. THE TONGUE SQUEEZES WHAT IT TAKES IN AND SWALLOWED.

WHALESKINS BECOME FLIPPERS, WHALETEETH REMAIN AS INTER-  
VESTIGES. HAIR LINGERS AS BRISTLES, BUT THEY HAVE DIED.  
A LAYER OF BLUBBER WHICH PROTECTS THEM IN THE POLAR  
WHERE THEIR FOOD IS MOST PLENTIFUL, MIGRATING TO  
REGIONS TO CALVE, FEEDING THEIR YOUNG ON RICH MILK.



### AGE OF OLD TOM

Local legend put his age between 50 and 90 years, however a silver threepence tooth shows 25 dentine layers. There are approximately 10 additional dentine layers totaling 35 growth layer groups. Based on this count "OLD TOM" may have been 35 years old.


